

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the minimum team size?

Teams must have at least ten (10) team members. Of course, there is no maximum for the number of people on a team!

What is the best way for teams to register?

ONLINE! It is easier for you, your team members and us. Online registration also allows each team member to establish a personalized online fundraising page, set a goal and start fundraising early. Log onto www.komensanantonio.org to start the online registration process.

Can you guarantee my team shirt sizes?

We do our best to order sufficient t-shirts in a variety of sizes. Despite our best efforts, sometimes we do run out of sizes and unfortunately, shirts. This is yet another reason why we encourage early online registration.

What are the registration fees for team members?

The registration fees are as follows:

- \$40 Adult Timed Competitive Run
- \$30 Adult Non-Competitive Run/Walk
- \$23 Survivor Timed Competitive Run
- \$20 Survivor Non-Competitive Run/Walk
- \$15 Child Age 3 through 12
- \$ 0 Child Age 2 and under (Free)
- \$38 Men for the Cure
- \$45 Sleep in for the Cure
- \$34 Survivor Sleep in for the Cure

Do all team members have to participate in the same event?

No. Team members can choose any event they wish. Often, competitive runners join their other team members for the 5K walk as well.

Does it matter who gets which Race bib?

Every participant needs a bib (Race number) including children. Bibs show that you have registered and are permitted to participate in the Race. Survivors are assigned pink bibs. Competitive runners are assigned yellow bibs with their timing chips attached to insure their time is officially recorded under his/her name.

What is the final date to register?

Online registration closes on Friday, April 9th.

How can my team members register after the team registration deadline?

Anyone who missed the team registration deadline may register to participate as an individual online, by mail or at an onsite registration site. These individuals can still walk or run with your team, but will not be counted as a team member for awards consideration.

Can I bring my dog? Use a skateboard? Ride my bike? Bring my stroller?

For the safety of all participants, pets, skateboards, bikes, rollerblades, stilts, scooters, etc. are not permitted at this event. We urge participants with baby strollers/joggers to begin the Race at the back of the non-competitive group for the safety of all other Race participants. We appreciate your cooperation!

When is Packet Pickup?

Team Packet Pickup is where team captains pick up the Race t-shirts and bibs for their team members prior to Race day. Individual team members may not pick up their T-shirt and bib numbers. They must get their items from their team captain. Team Packet Pickup will take place at the Alamo Quarry Market on Monday, April 26th from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m.
